

## **SEELEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

### **Board Policy No. 0420: School Plans / Site Councils**

The Governing Board encourages employees, students, parents/guardians and other members of the school community to develop school plans designed to meet the specific needs at individual school sites. The Board may approve or disapprove school plans as necessary in order to fulfill the district's mission, accomplish the Board's adopted goals and/or comply with legal requirements.

When submitting a consolidated application for state and federal categorical programs to the California Department of Education, the Superintendent or designee shall assure that a single plan for student achievement has been prepared in accordance with law.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the school establishes and maintains a school site council. The council shall be responsible for the development, review and modification of school plans and for other duties as prescribed by law.
